Text

Thousands of people are spending a second night in freezing temperatures in winter climate after Sunday's 7.2 magnitude earthquake in eastern Turkey. **They** are trembling while waiting for any hope under ruins. Rescue teams have continued to search for survivors under the ruins of hundreds of collapsed buildings.

Deputy Prime Minister Bulent Arinc said 279 people had died. They predicted 1,300 people were injured and most of **them** in the cities of Van and Erics, near the Iranian border. With hundreds of people missing, the death toll will probably rise. There is no cure for the people who lost families.

At one site, a six year old girl called Ellis Janpolat is missing. She had gone outside to play when the earthquake hit. About 75,000 people of Erics population has been the worst hit, with some 80 collapsed buildings. There is no space inside the tents. The chances of still alive people are decreasing day by day because of poor nutrition inside the ruins. The BBC's Daniel Stanford, says many destroyed apartments were full of dozens of people missing. It is hard to say « be fine and never look back » as **they** are about to lose their mind.
